 Land Governance: management is carried out by computers with people participation

BP evolution

- LG: BP-reingineering due to new tools
- LG: BP ontologies for E-Governement

Ontologies - knowledge of BP in W (BP).

BP must be identified, specified and described in the special languages. Ontology should be sufficient for the electronic government agent interactions with customers and conducting BP (Web 2.0 technology or semantic Web).

Ontologies are specified in the special languages BPM: UML, IDEF, BPEL, IDEF, WSML, BPEL4WS

Quality assessment evolution


- LG is not a simple management. This is a «good», purposeful management for Sustainable Development, responded toMillennium Development Goals - MDGs




