Item 1: Opening and adoption of the agenda

The Chair of the Working Party, Mr. Fredrik Zetterquist, opened the meeting. The Bureau adopted the report of the previous meeting with one amendment. The Bureau then adopted the agenda.

Item 2: Programme of Work 2020-2021, including the work of Task Groups and status on actions

Studies on selected topics in land management

- 2.1.1 **PPPs in Land Administration study** The WPLA will consider endorsing the study at its twelfth session.
- 2.1.2 **Fraud in Land Administration** The WPLA will consider endorsing the study at its twelfth session.
- 2.1.3 **COVID-19 Recovery Action Plan for Informal Settlements in the UNECE Region** The information document (complete draft Action Plan) will be circulated for review and approval to the bureau after its next meeting in April before the secretariat submits it to the Working Party for endorsement at its twelfth session.

2.1.4 Prindex study - Security of Property Rights in UNECE region: Comparative Report: An assessment of perceived tenure security for land and housing property among UNECE countries – The bureau was informed that Prindex will revised and redraft the report based on the comments provided to Prindex by the WPLA. We are awaiting the new draft form review.

Capacity-building and international knowledge sharing:

2.2.1 Planning for a series of WPLA-FAO joint webinars on "Land Administration during COVID-19" – The second webinar was held on 15 April 2021 with attendance of close to 60 participants. The secretariat updated the Bureau on the planning for the third webinar which will be held on 11 May and will be led by the Russian Federation. The webinars are organized jointly with FAO, on the following topics (i) accelerated digitalization (country lead: UK, Victoria Abbott), (ii) COVID-19 and the effects on the property market (country lead: Norway, Elena Busch) and (iii) NSDI, geospatial data and technology and response to COVID-19 and the role of geospatial and cadastre agencies (country lead: Russian Federation, Konstantin Litvintsev). The above-mentioned bureau members will also summarize key conclusions and learnings from the webinars to inform the discussion under item 2 of the provisional agenda of the twelfth session of the Working Party. There will also be an opportunity to ask questions from the participants as to what further topics might be of interest for future webinars. A proposal to use Slido to gather these answers.

Item 3: Twelfth session of the WPLA

- 3.1.1 Malta still has not come back with the Host Country Agreement yet as there is still some uncertainty with the COVID-19 pandemic safety measures so the decision on we there to move the Session to Geneva will be taken at the end of April 2021.
- 3.1.2 **Scenario Study on Future Land Administration** During the twelfth session, the Working Party will be invited to discuss this draft study, including the methodology, the scenarios and the self-assessment questionnaire. Including a series of interactive polls to engage the participants. The Chair will send a list of the draft questions through Mentimeter for the bureau to review and propose any additions. The WPLA will consider endorsing the study at its twelfth session.
- 3.1.3 Planning for the thematic discussions during the session The secretariat presented an updated draft of the detailed programme of the twelfth session of the Working Party, in particular speakers for items 2 "Land administration during the COVID-19 pandemic" and 3 "Review of scenarios for future land administration" need to be urgently identified. The secretariat updated the detailed planning in the light of the discussion and will reshare it with the Bureau for discussion at its next meeting.
