UN Regulation No. 150.01 (Item 8)

The latest baseline (doc. GRE/2021/15) was carefully reviewed for a final error check. Document SLR-50-07 shows all the small corrections and embellishments identified and agreed during SLR-50. The Secretary will prepare an informal document for SLR-51 to collect all the main corrections to be submitted to GRE-85 for adoption. The "Homework Team" for R-150 shall review the definitions in Annex 4, Part 1, paragraph 2 and update the text accordingly. These changes will be reviewed at SLR-51 and then added to the informal document.

"Homework Teams" R148, R149, R150

The 3 "Homework Teams" should improve and update the presentations summarising the main modifications introduced with the 01 series of amendments and the correlation tables between Stage 1 and 2 for each of new device Regulations. The presentations will be sent to GRE-85 as informal documents after a general "rehearsal" during SLR-51. The correlation tables, instead, are not intended for submission to GRE-85 but rather as a tool for SLR to answer questions during GRE, as well as for keeping track of the evolution of the Regulations from Stage 1 to Stage 2.

10.	The Secretary shared some suggestions, received by the GRE Secretariat from industry, to streamline the requirements in R148.	
	SLR pointed out that proposals should be made through proper channels, however it was observed that the identified problems in Reg. 148 have been solved already with the restructuring introduced with the 01 series of amendments to Reg. 148.	
	Preparation for Simplification "Stage 2 / Step 2"	
11.	The Chairman provided a general introduction on the preparation to start the Simplification "Stage 2 / Step 2". The first task will be the creation of "Homework teams" for installation Regulations, similar to what has been done in the past for the device Regulations. He explained that "Homework teams" work in-between the SLR sessions in order to make progress with the proposals, however all decisions shall always be taken by SLR.	
	Although all CPs and NGOs involved in SLR are expected to actively contribute in the Simplification "Stage 2 / Step 2", due to the specific focus on Installation, it was proposed that OICA, IMMA and CEMA should lead these new "Homework teams", for the Regulations of their competence. They will confirm at SLR-51 the names of the "Homework team Captains" for Reg. 48 (OICA), Regs. 53 and 74 (IMMA) and Reg. 86 (CEMA).	
	HID colour restrictions	
12.	Mr. Schlager informed that IEC decided to target GRE-86 instead of GRE-85 and, in the meantime, side discussions will take place with those CPs having concerns. An updated timeline will be provided by IEC for SLR-51.	
13.	Parking Lamps
