Discussion about AEBS deactivation

With regards to AEBS-HDV-08 (2021-11-30)

Current proposals

- 1. AEBS-HDV-07 re-issued (CLEPA-OICA) AEBS deactivation:
 It shall not be possible to manually deactivate the AEBS at a speed above 60 km/h. The AEBS shall automatically be reinstated after a cumulated time of 10 minutes above 70km/h. Additionally, it shall always be possible for the driver to reactivate AEBS.
- Originated in AEBS-HDV-08: Once manually deactivated, the AEBS shall be automatically reinstated after a distance travelled of [15] km. Additionally, it shall always be possible for the driver to reactivate AEBS.
- 3. Industry proposal 1 (dedicated meeting on AEBS deactivation):
 Once manually deactivated, the AEBS shall be automatically reinstated after a cumulated time of 10 minutes above 70km/h. Additionally ,it shall always be possible for the driver to reactivate AEBS.
- 4. Industry proposal 2 (dedicated meeting on AEBS deactivation):
 A manual deactivation at speeds below [10km/h or 15km/h] shall be terminated latest after a cumulated time of 10 minutes above 70km/h. Any manual deactivation at a speed above [10km/h or 15km/h] shall be terminated latest after 15km. Additionally, it shall always be possible for the driver to reactivate AEBS.
