## Proposal for harmonizing the structure of the file name of the documents downloaded from DETA


**Current**: No standard filename structure **Proposed**: Eyy-30R02-21-nnnnnn-zz-##-XXXXX.pdf

**Example:** E4-30R02-21-123456-01-CERT.pdf

## Rationale

- Currently there is no standardized file naming format for upload to TAA or storing in DETA database.
- While the documents downloaded from DETA carry the same name as the uploaded documents, this can currently result in cases where there is no indication on the type of document and the approval number they refer to.
- ETRTO proposal aims to harmonize the file naming structure in DETA database between all stakeholders.
- Harmonization would help both the manufacturers and the TAA's regarding the management of the documents.
