The Permanent Mission of Japan to the International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe and, with reference to Japan's submission of a status report on the regulations established under the AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHING OF GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES, done at Geneva on 25 June 1998, has the honour to submit the following report on the status of Global Technical Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the "UN GTR") No.22 in Japan's domestic process in accordance with paragraph 7.4 of Article 7 of the abovementioned Agreement.

**UN GTR No. 22: Battery durability for electrified vehicles**

The Government of Japan made it mandatory to install State-of-Certified Energy (SOCE) and State-of-Certified Range (SOCR) monitors (for new types: from October 2024, for all new sales: from October 2026), while considering whether and how other requirements are adopted, taking into account the current discussion regarding amendment of UN GTR No. 22 under WP.29.

The Permanent Mission of Japan to the International Organizations in Geneva avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe the assurances of its highest consideration.
