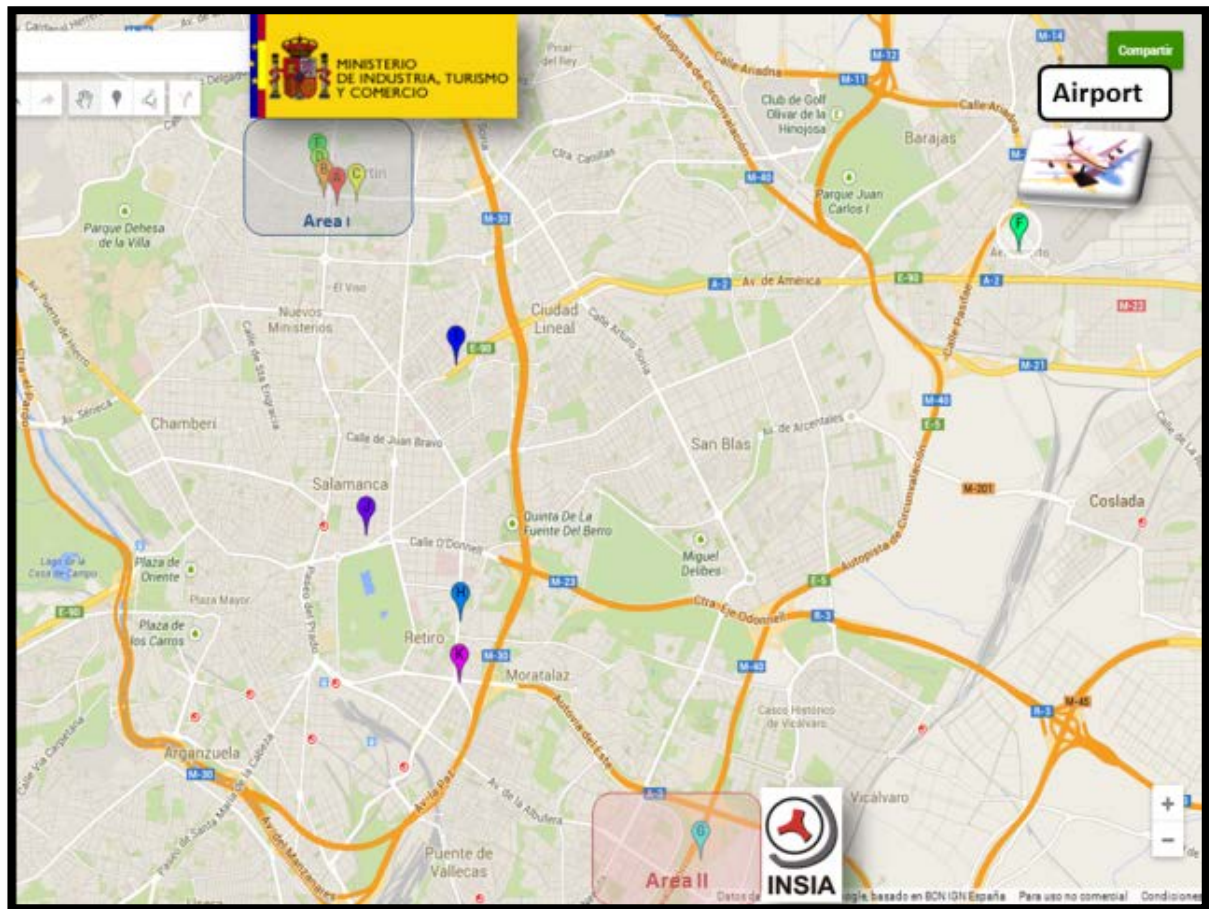
Directions from the airport, hotel recommendations, transportation info, as well as information on Madrid are attached to this invitation.

Area Map for HDH and HDH-DG Meetings:

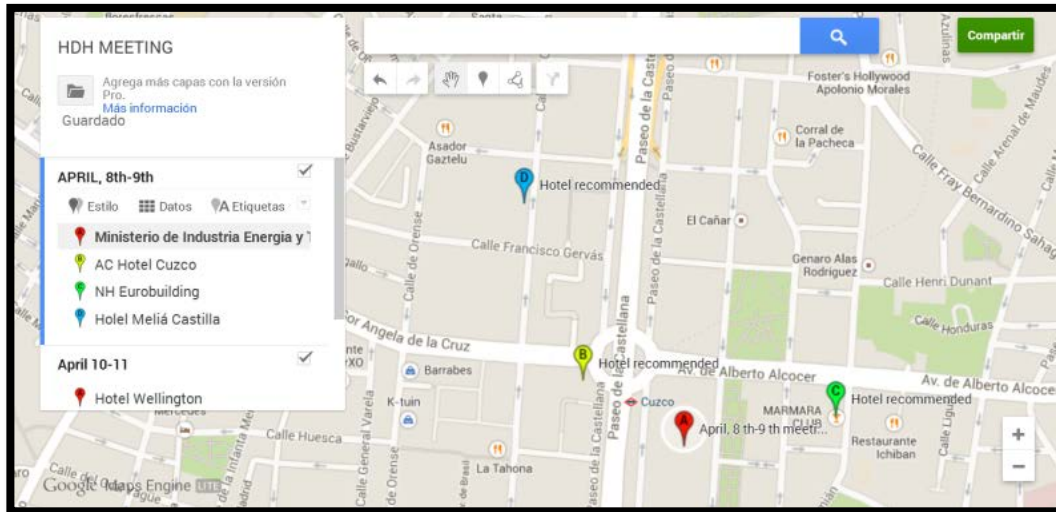

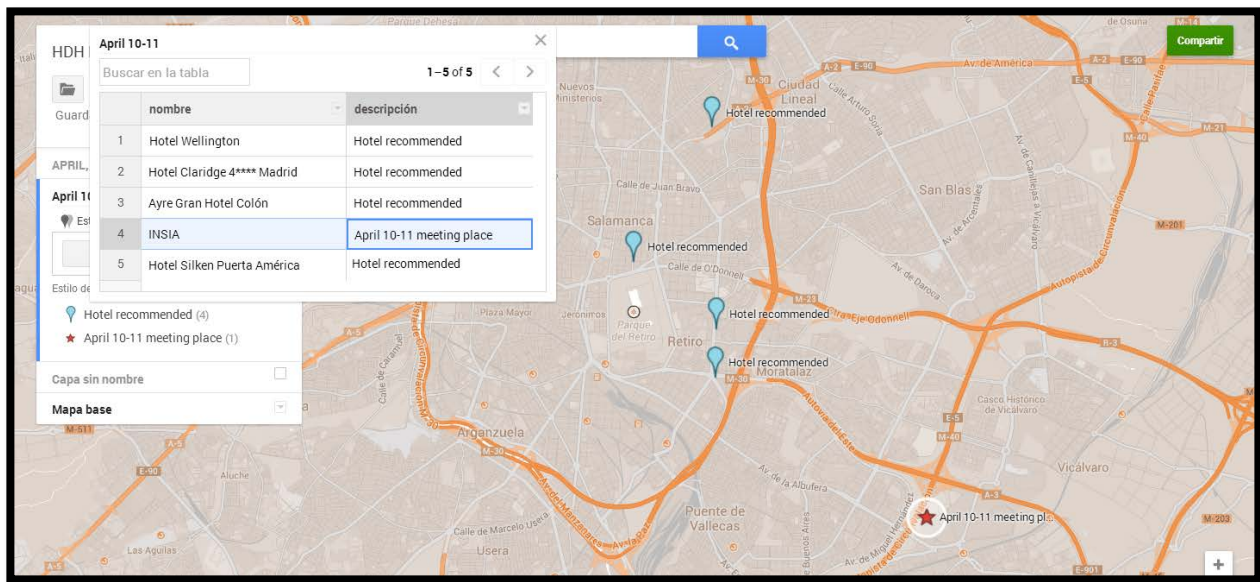

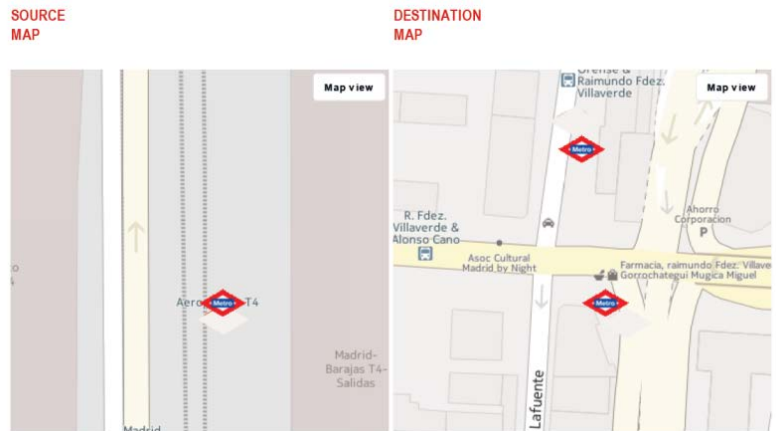
Section by Underground

2. Bus: Airport Express Line

Airport Express Line: It provides a direct connection between Atocha (Cibeles at night) and Barajas airport 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

A frequent service: Approximately 13 to 20 minutes during the day and every 35 overnight.

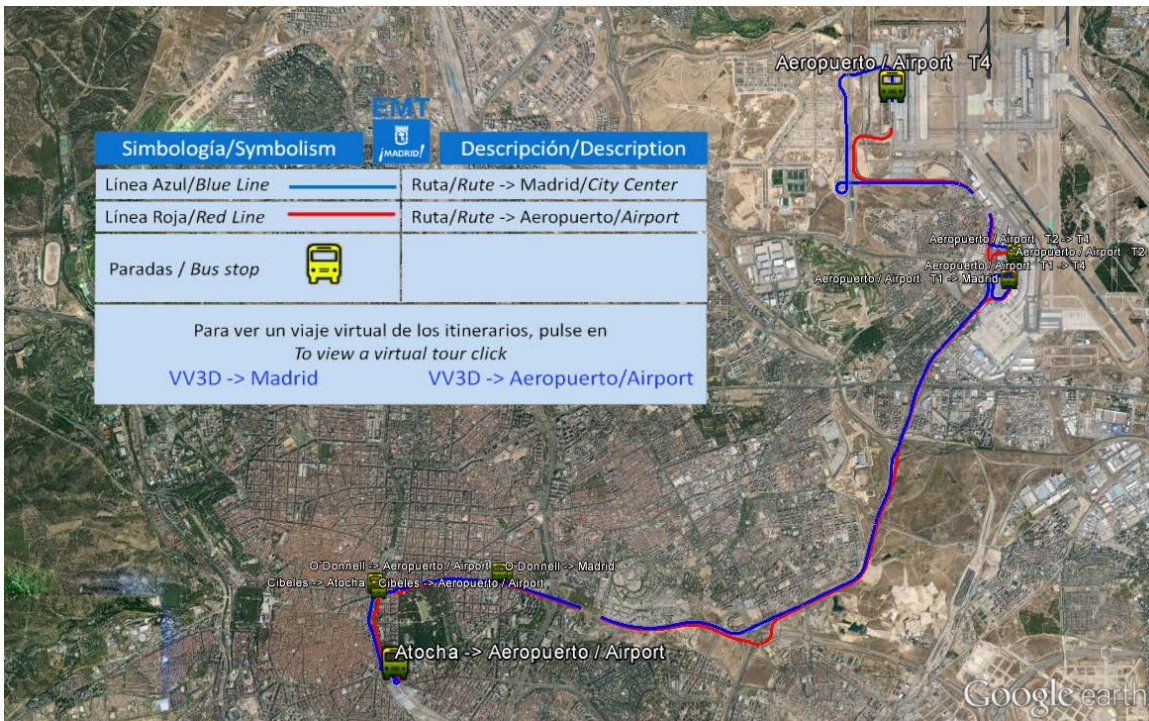
A quick trip: Just 40 minutes in normal traffic conditions.

A direct service: Straight to the heart of Madrid.

A ready way: It has four stops in the most central areas of the city that connects to the rest of the transport network.

AIRPORT RATES

Rate 4:

When traveling to or from between the airport and inside the Calle 30, including those who have been hired by electronic means, a fixed rate of 30 euros applies.

At this fixed rate will not be able to add any supplement or the maximum amount of contracted services by electronic means shall apply, provided that the passenger is at the meeting point at the agreed time.
