- 1.8. ADS features
- 1.8.1. An ADS feature refers to an application of ADS capabilities designed for use within a defined ODD. In the case of an ADS designed to operate within a single ODD, the ADS and the ADS feature are synonymous. **Examples of ADS features are highway-only driving and automated parking.**
- 1.8.2 Although an ADS performs the entire DDT on a sustained basis, an ADS with separate ADS features may be designed to operate within more than one ODD.
- 1.8.32. Each set of ODD-specific capabilities has a unique set of constraints defining the conditions under which the ADS may be used.
- 1.8.3. An ADS feature refers to an application of ADS capabilities designed for use within a defined ODD. In the case of an ADS designed to operate within a single ODD, the ADS and the ADS feature are synonymous.

Justification
