Review of the draft text of the interim submission to GRVA/WP.29

During the 33rd session in Tokyo, FRAV reviewed paragraphs 1 through 1.5.5. and paragraphs 2 through 5.9.5.1. The outcomes were distributed to the FRAV experts in a revised version of document FRAV-33-38. FRAV will continue the review based on a "clean version" of this document (FRAV-34-04).

FRAV status report to GRVA

The WP.29 Framework Document on Automated/Autonomous Vehicles (FDAV) mandates FRAV submission of guidelines for regulatory requirements and for verifiable criteria for ADS safety validation for the June 2023 WP.29 session (WP.29-188-12). The FDAV further mandates a consolidated FRAV/VMAD submission (requirements and assessment) for the June 2024 session.

FRAV will inform the January 23-27 session of GRVA on the status of work towards meeting the mandates. During the 33rd session, FRAV will discuss the status of work and key points to be communicated to GRVA.

Next steps

FRAV will determine plans for further meetings, including a potential session during 19-20 January.
