
(IIII) HDV TP component level verification

- Acceptance of component level verification for HDV REESS




Vehicle component offering






Customer configurations





High variance of applications for one REESS in HDV segment

A truck or bus, regardless of dimensions or application, can have any number of combinations of REESS families (see separate presentation) fitted in locations dependant upon customer needs





Example

- Chassis truck layout offering for customer (body builder)
 - Part-WVTA, 9 vehicles purchased
 - 6 REESS/vehicle, belong to 4 REESS families
 - REESSs installation varies according to customer's application
 - Customer responsible for vehicle level conformance
 - How many vehicle level verifications?
