The factory premises may not be accessed without a Lumileds escort.

1 Access control

- Always register at the Central Point of Entry (CPoE) when accessing the factory premises and prove your identity with your official identification document.
- Persons under the age of 16 may access the premises only under adult supervision.
- Wear your visitor pass visibly.
- Visitor parking lots are available at the entrance to the factory premises (see map).

2 Traffic rules

- The German traffic regulations (StVO) must be observed throughout the entire factory premises. The speed limit is 15 km/h.
- Pedestrians and forklift traffic shall have priority.
 Accidents shall be reported by the visitors to CPoE staff members.

3 Exiting the factory premises

- De-registration is to be made at CPoE.
- The visitor pass must be returned there or left in the letter box provided for at CPoE.
- The staff members of CPoE are authorized to carry out checks on persons, bags or vehicles.

4 General regulations

 Taking photographs and filming shall only be allowed with prior authorization of the respective plant manager.



 Smoking is generally prohibited and exclusively allowed within the marked areas.



 Facilities, machinery and locker rooms shall only be used with the authorization of the plant management.



 Raw materials, intermediate products, plants and plant components may not be touched.



5 Safety instructions

 The personal protective equipment must be worn in the specifically identified areas:







- Prior to carrying out hot work (welding, thermal cutting, grinding, angle grinding etc.) the authorization of the fire prevention officer must be obtained. Necessary fire extinguishers must be provided by the company carrying out the work.
- The same shall be applicable to work causing smoke and dust.
 - Watch out for in-house forklift traffic



 Keep a hand on the rail to avoid falling and tripping accidents.



6 Hazardous substances

- Hazardous substances may only be used on the premises with written permission of the respective safety and environmental protection officer. The staff members must be instructed how to handle the hazardous substances used.
- Substances must not be dumped into drains/wash hand basins. Waste disposal is the responsibility of the visiting company.



7 First aid / Fire / Environmental damages / Emergency

- In the case of emergency dial 112 and also the phone number (+49/241 539-)2222.
 - When the alarm sounds:
 - ightarrow Exit the building immediately via the shortest route and go to the meeting points.





→ Follow the instructions of the fire department.
