

## NGVA Europe view on level concept


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NGVA Europe supports the idea of the level concept proposed by Korea.

At the same time, NGVA Europe proposes a simplified approach to this topic.



Original proposal by Korea



NGVA Europe suggests to develop in each subgroups the full methodology, at the maximum detail level possible (equivalent to Level #4).

A-LCA IWG is not in charge to calculate data and populate databases. Therefore, in this phase it should 'only' develop the methodology.

Each subgroup should define a 'simplified' level of analysis, that can be temporally adopted if for any reason the full analysis cannot be developed (for example, due to the lack of data).

This simplified level can correspond to Level #1, Level #2 or Level 3. For each phase, the level shall be unique, but different phases can have different equivalent level.



Example of simplified level of analysis (to be evaluated by each SG according to the availability of data at 31.12.2025)

## Advantages of this proposal:

- The methodology of the full analysis will be available at the end of the A-LCA IWG mandate.
- A simplified methodology will be immediately applicable.
- The full methodology could be implemented once data available.
- Only two levels of analysis are possible: FULL or SIMPLIFIED.
- More clarity when comparing different companies.
- Avoid different requirements from CPs, forcing companies to develop several levels of analysis.



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
