Under nominal scenarios, an ADS is expected to demonstrate behavioural competencies consistent with the requirements for DDT performance. <b>One of those competencies would be the ability to avoid getting into critical situations through the exercise of careful and competent driving such that, when there is an elevated risk of the occurrence of a critical situation, the vehicle's driving behaviour should be adjusted accordingly.</b>	This proposed change is intended to indicate that a well-designed ADS will try to prevent the occurrence of critical situations rather than just waiting for them to happen and then reacting to them. This quality of anticipation of elevated risk is an inherent skill of careful and competent driving. The current text does fully encapsulate that concept.
