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Meeting

Agenda Item 1: Welcome and introduction

The chair greeted the attendees and moved on to the initial agenda item.

Agenda item 2: Approve agenda

Agenda item 3: Adoption of the last meeting minutes

Agenda item 4: Update of any new information:

- The co-chair/JRC presented the state of play of the ongoing discussions within the working group.
- OICA on maintenance:

Building on prior discussions from SG4 meetings, OICA presented the next steps for maintenance within the Service Life framework:

- Compilation of a comprehensive list of maintenance items
- Development of a methodology for determining maintenance frequency
- Collaboration with SG3 regarding the availability of carbon emission data (primary/secondary)
- Proposal of draft text with technical rationale

Options for Maintenance Frequency:

Two options were deliberated:

- 1. Distance-based maintenance
- 2. Time-based maintenance

The group leans towards frequency based on distance due to its ease of calculation. OICA also updated the group on discussions with GreenNCAP regarding the availability of maintenance parts and consumable data.

Discussion:

Riccardo and Japan raised points regarding data availability, suggesting that whichever metric, time or distance, is reached first should dictate maintenance schedules. However, replacement of traction battery and FC stack would need a more detailed and complex calculation rather than a fixed number based on time/distance.

Service Life Definition:

The morning session included discussions on defining service life. It was agreed that while each region may define it differently, clarity in reporting is crucial for fair comparisons between vehicles worldwide. Detailed minutes will follow, and an expert meeting is scheduled before April 16th. Those interested in participating are encouraged to contact OICA via email.

Agenda item 5: Presentation from Japan

Japan presented their position on Determining CO2eq during the Use Phase (SG4) at the level concept/Representative vehicles, anticipating concrete proposals from OICA.

Following the presentation, comments were solicited for clarification. Further discussion will be continued in the next sessions with the aim of reaching a consensus.

Agenda item 6: Presentation from VECC – data collection and databases

VECC delivered a presentation on their Experience & Methods for Accessing Emissions during the Usage Phase, focusing on emission control practices in China.

VECC/GALM are currently in the process of developing advanced emission control standards for both pollutants and greenhouse gases in both light and heavy-duty vehicles in China. This effort aligns with the regulations outlined in the Air Pollution Prevention and Control Law, which mandates that manufacturers and importers of motor vehicles and non-road mobile machinery must disclose environmental information to the public, including emission inspection data and pollution control technology details. They are held accountable for ensuring the accuracy, timeliness, and completeness of the disclosed information.

The Chair warmly welcomed VECC's participation in SG4.
