Goals and objectives of ADS IWG | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Co-chair/UK explained goals and objectives of ADS IWG referring to “Program of work (WP.29/2024/1/Rev.1)” and “TOR for ADS IWG (ADS-01-05). ➤ GRVA Chair/Germany wished the goal of ADS IWG to be achieved on time despite its tight schedule. ADS IWG and WS would develop different sections of GTR/UN R respectively in an efficient manner. |
| 4. Organizational structure | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ GRVA Chair/Germany explained “the setup, planning and tasks of the GRVA workshops (ADS-01-04)”. He introduced Ambassadors/Australia and NL who serve not only as point of contacts, but also give advice and recommendations to both IWG and WS. |
| 5. General work plan and Managing work | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Co-chair/UK explained the work plan as follows referring to “ADS GTR/UNR Content (ADS-01-03). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Big Sections “General requirements”, “Performance requirements/Test specifications”, and “Assessment/Test procedures” are to be broken down into manageable pieces which will be assigned to OPI accordingly. - Sections “Purpose”, “Scope”, and “Definitions” are assigned to Technical Secretary/AAPC. - Sections “Recommendations” and “Existing regulations, directives, ----” can be assigned immediately. ➤ OPI is a point of contact and a coordinator who is responsible for its section. OPI will receive assistance of experts in ADS IWG. ➤ ADS IWG members are requested to become OPI for sections “Recommendations” and “Existing regulations, directives, ----”. Volunteers are advised to reach Secretaries. ➤ OICA regarded the structure proposed by Leadership as old style. OICA considers proposing some new structure suitable for ADS regulation by the next GRVA in May. ➤ The Russian Federation pointed out to take into account the new DCAS requirements for the description of a thorough ADS assessment process. |
