3.	Adoption of the agenda	SLR-06-01/Rev.1
	The agenda was adopted with minor modifications as reflected in document SLR-06-01/Rev.1.	
	Approval of the report of the previous session	SLR-05-19
4.	The Report was approved without modifications.	
5.	Updated sections of the draft resolution for common administrative provisions	SLR-06-02
	Mr. Puglisi informed that all the updates sections of the draft resolution have been put together into a ZIP folder and circulated as document SLR-06-02.	
	The draft text for the definition section (i.e. Section 2) was examined in details and several improvements were made.	
	The following is a list of the most significant changes and conclusions that were agreed by the SLR:	

➤ The **numbering of sub-paragraphs** has been slightly modified to keep it shorter:

Previous numbering

- 2.4. Definitions for devices
 - 2.4.1 Definitions for lighting devices
 - 2.4.2. Definitions for light-signalling devices
 - 2.4.3. Definitions for adaptive front lighting
 - 2.4.4. Definitions for retro-reflecting devices

New numbering

- 2.4. General definitions for devices
- 2.5. Definitions for lighting devices
- 2.6. Definitions for light-signalling devices
- 2.7. Definitions for retro-reflectors
- ➤ The definitions will remain **not in alphabetic order** as it was recognized that today the search for definitions is made electronically and no longer on paper.
- ➤ Throughout the text the word "shall" was substituted, as necessary, with alternative text to remove requirements from definitions.
- ➤ The definition of "Overall dimensions" was deleted because superfluous, having already the definitions of "Overall length" and "Overall width". It was inserted by mistake and the current text is now aligned to the original version of Reg. 48. To avoid renumbering, Par. 2.4.13. was maintained as follows:
 - 2.4.13 Overall dimensions
 - 2.4.13.1 "Overall width"...
 - 2.4.13.2. "Overall length"...
- ➤ It was agreed to leave unchanged the double **terminology** "Driving-beam / main-beam" and "Passing-beam / dipped-beam"
- ➤ It was agreed to add a **preamble** before the scope to explain that this Resolution applies only to those UN Regulations making a direct reference to it and not the other ones.

Taking into account the indications provided by OLA in document GRE-74-15 (i.e. "Regulations can only be amended in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 12 of the Agreement" and "A Resolution cannot be employed to amend a Regulation"), the meeting agreed to continue with a Resolution document but with static references in the Regulations.

It was acknowledged that such a solution would generate the need to make regular collective amendments but this seemed to be acceptable by the EC since their contents would be very simple.

This approach should provide the necessary legal certainty (due to the static references) while keeping the process still compliant to Art. 12 (due to the approval procedure of collective amendments).
