1 Adoption of the Agenda (ITS/AD-01-01)	Agreement 1: Mr. Inomata was introduced and approved as a co-chair for the remainder of 2015. The meeting re-appointed Mr Yarnold and Mr Inomata for 2016.
3-1 Discussion on how to proceed with the joint working of WP.1 and WP.29 (ITS/AD-06-03, ITS/AD-06-04)	Agreement 2: Having considered the joint working of WP.1 and WP.29, it was agreed to propose to WP.29 that ITS/AD IG send its representative (ambassador) to WP.1 as well as to the IGs under WP.1 in order for the two working parties to establish closer working and to share information.
3-2 Definition of Automated Driving Technology (ITS/AD-06-05, ITS/AD-06-06)	<p>Common observation 1: OICA explained how to define the levels of automated driving; the members of ITS/AD IG recognised the need to study and discuss the system's warnings to the driver to resume dynamic driving task (HMI) as well as the measure to be taken in case of the driver's failure to resume such task.</p> <p>Action item 1: It was decided to continue the discussion and to coordinate various definitions at the March 2016 meeting.</p>
3-3 Information communication security related to automated driving (ITS/AD-06-09, ITS/AD-06-10, ITS/AD-06-11)	<p>Agreement 3: The Netherlands highlighted the issues for the integrity of software security; it was agreed to report and seek guidance from WP.29 at its session the following week.</p> <p>Agreement 4: Germany presented a paper on Cyber security – highlighting the discussions at the G7 transport ministers event on 17 September It was agreed that delegates should submit opinions on Germany's document regarding by Thursday, 17 December.</p> <p>Action item 2: It was decided that the cybersecurity guidelines developed by Japan from a standpoint of safety be integrated with Germany's document by the March 2016 meeting.</p>

Other Business</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Progress on GRRF/ACFS (ITS/AD-06-13) • Progress on GRSG/eSafety 	<p>Agreement 5: It was agreed to upload a document regarding the definition of ACSF function categories (A-E) based on GRRF's discussions onto the UN website as ITS/AD IG's document (ITS/AD-06-13).</p> <p>Agreement 5: It was reported that the UK would discuss the details of EDR at the next GRSG session; it was agreed that ITS/AD IG would take necessary actions based on its outcome.</p>
