Clarification on intention for confidentiality of ISMR information

Reason for Change (Justification)

In previous IWG sessions there has been extensive discussion on what can be defined in the regulation regarding the confidentiality of ISMR reports received by authorities.

Paragraph 8.4.4 (UNR) and X.4.4 (GTR) “ The approval authority or its designated technical service shall ensure the confidentiality of sensitive and business confidential reported information in the short-term template.”

This does not refer to information that is not deemed “sensitive or business confidential”, nor does it cover any other authorities beyond the granting approval authority or its technical service (e.g. relevant authority).

The 43rd session of the Task Force on Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (TF ADAS) accepted an amendment for the information reported in R171, the amendment states “ **The information is not intended to be shared publicly.**”

This clarification explains the intention of the ISMR information while not conflicting with what can, or cannot, be defined in a UN Regulation.
