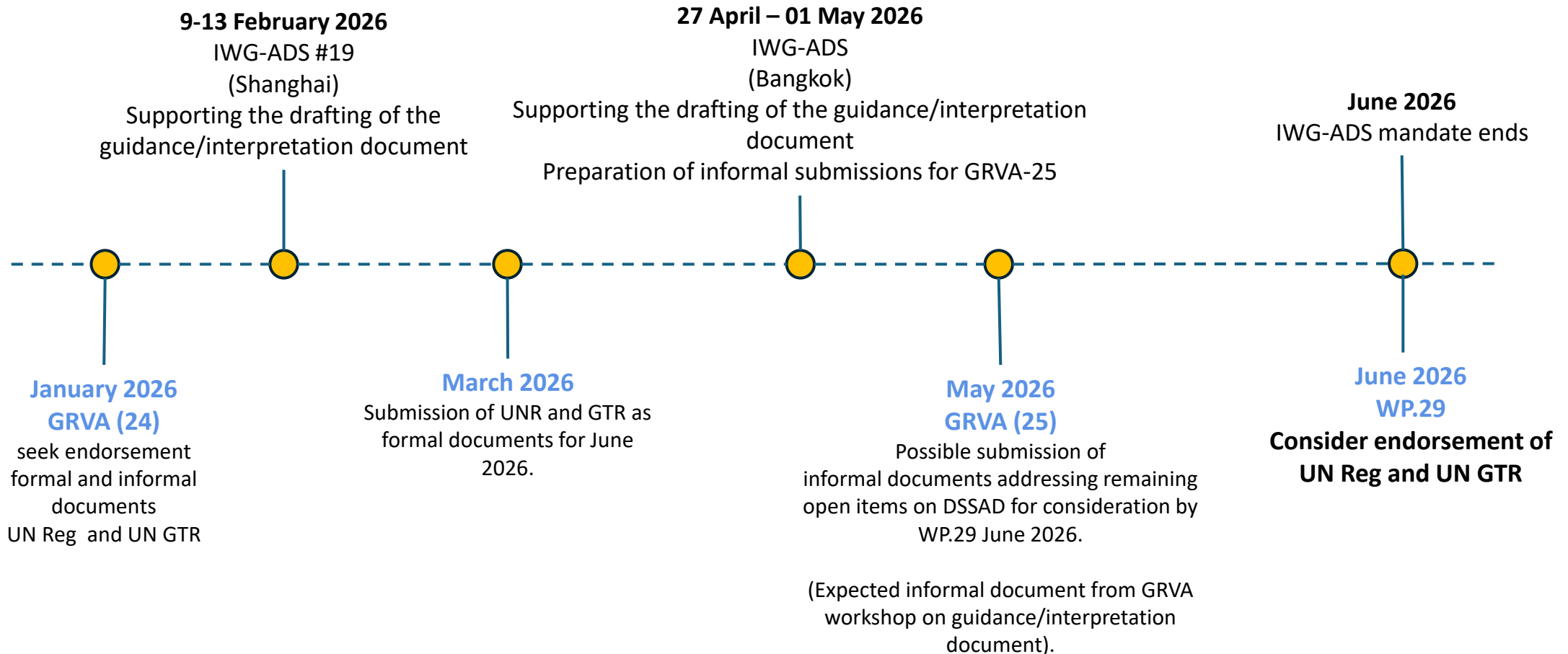

# Status of open items for June 2026

- Open items of the IWG-ADS resolved included, but not limited to:
  - Incorporating workshop text
  - Resolved all square brackets
  - Integrated DSSAD text
  - Editorial corrections
- The IWG-ADS is aware of items on DSSAD that are under discussion and to be resolved in time for WP.29 June 2026
  - Definition of 'detected objects'
  - Annex 6 (GTR) / Annex 8 (UNR) – recording interval for time-series data elements

# Activities beyond June 2026

- The IWG has identified several topics for future consideration by the IWG which fall into the following ‘buckets’:
  1. Items not addressed within the original versions of the GTR/UNR.
  2. Existing items that may require amending or improving resulting from further review of the GTR/UNR.
  3. Items relating to the operational implementation of the GTR/UNR.
  4. Any other items not included in 1-3.
- The IWG will draft revised ‘terms of reference’ for consideration.

# Ask of GRVA

- GRVA to submit the draft GTR and UNR to WP.29 as formal documents for consideration at its June 2026 session.
- GRVA to note that a further informal document anticipated to be submitted by the IWG-ADS to GRVA-25 (May 2026) to cover outstanding item(s) on DSSAD as put forward by the DSSAD experts.
