Draft minutes of the 13th meeting.

On-line meeting on the 25th of February 2026 with 29 participants.

Adoption of the agenda

A shorter agenda was approved.

Adoption of the minutes of last meeting

Minutes of the 12th meeting were approved.

Continued discussions

We discussed the assessment of the readiness of the HBM (in 3, 5, 10, 10+ years) using the Miro board. We added Skull fractures separately from Brain injuries. We added Lumbar Spine additionally to Cervical Spine (neck injuries). Based on the survey, which was sent to the HBM developers, we also added a General Kinematics region. Afterwards, the group complemented the list of injury metrics for each body region. Then, we started to discuss current data/knowledge gaps for the various injury metrics and tried to put an time for readiness behind.
