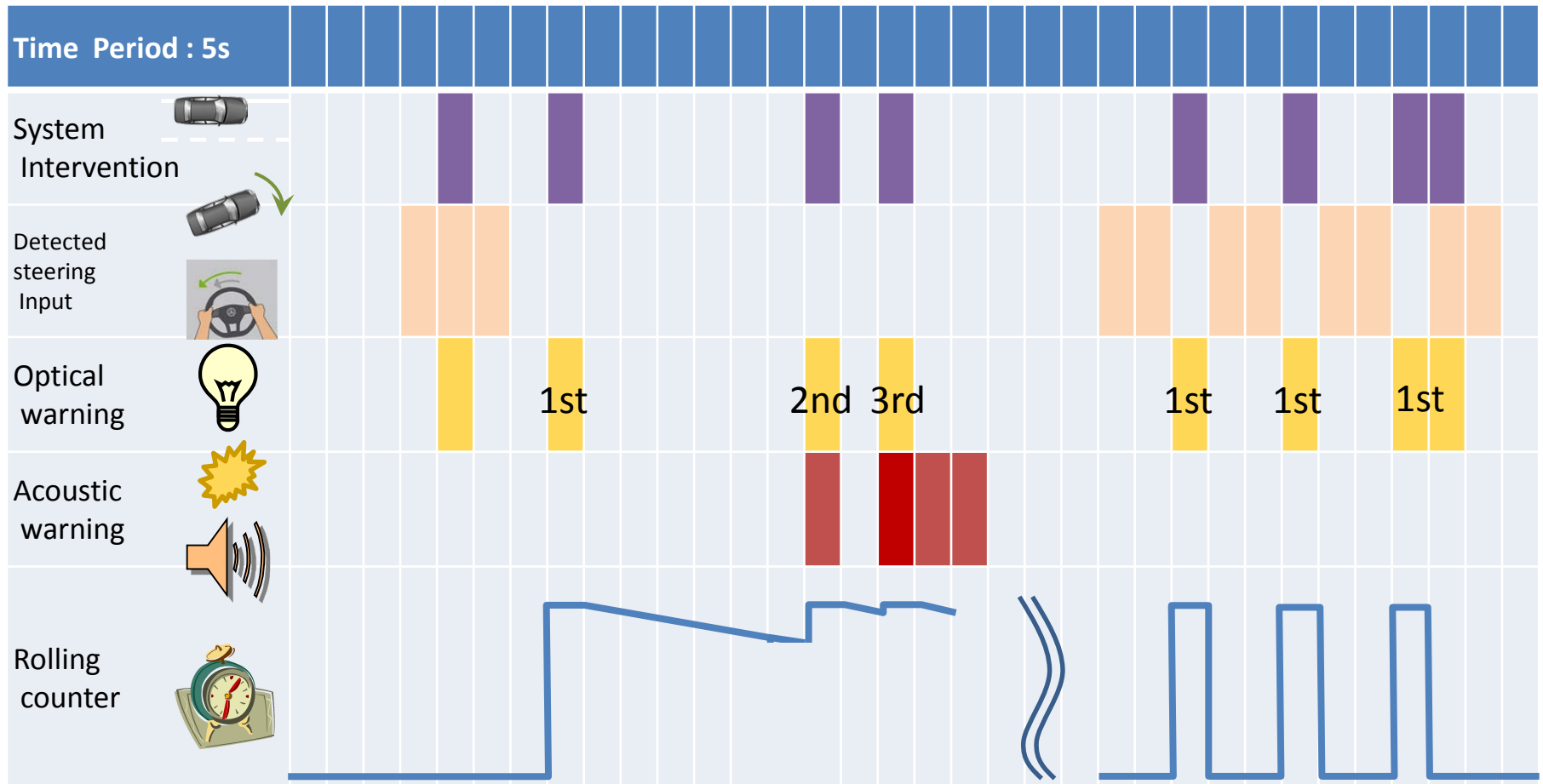

5.1.6.2.2.2. In the case of two or more consecutive interventions within a rolling interval of 180 seconds and in the absence of a steering input by the driver ~~during these interventions~~, an acoustic warning shall be provided by the system during the second and any further intervention within ~~this a~~ rolling interval of 180 seconds. 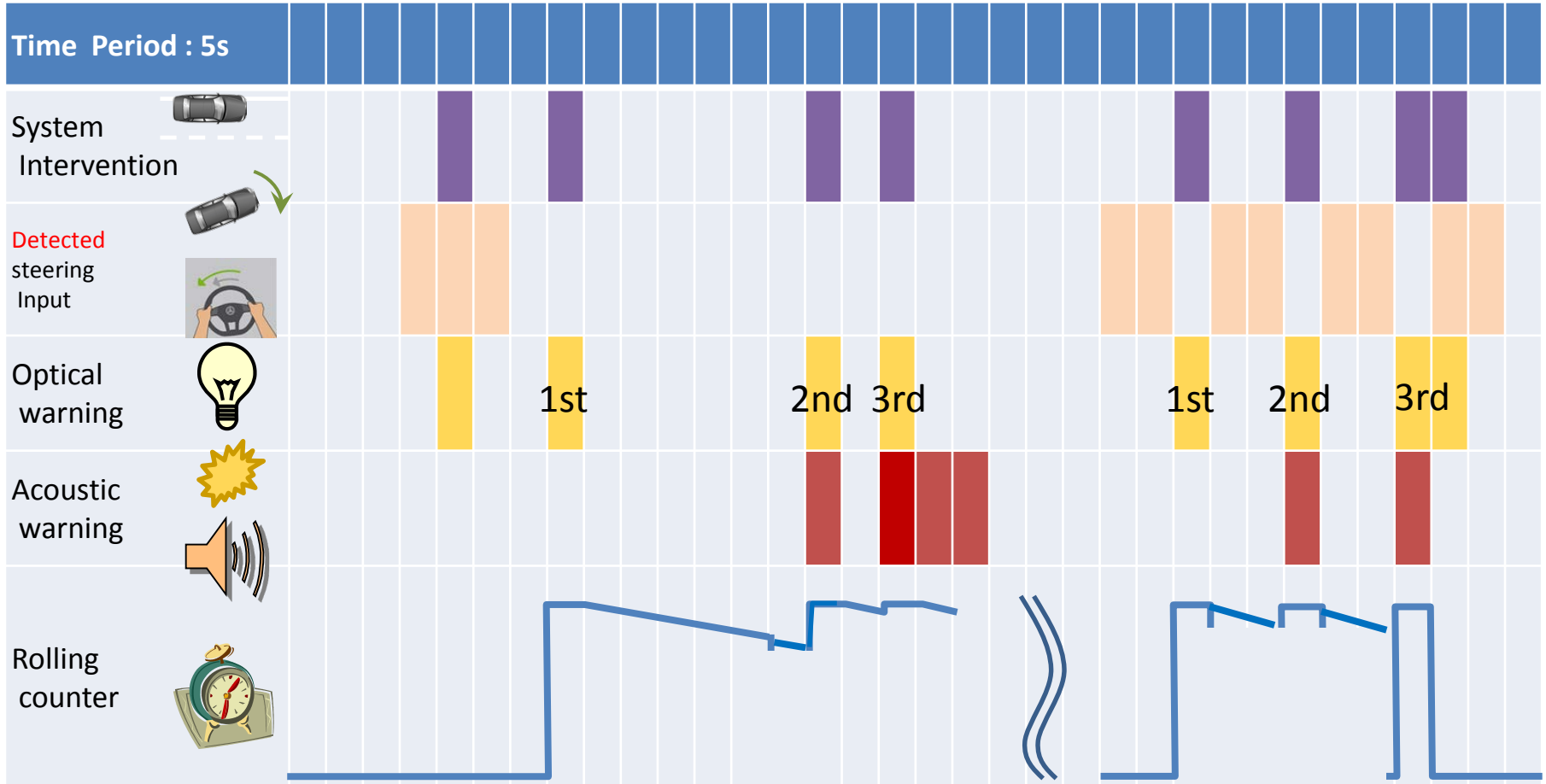
