

INVITATION TO THE 21st MEETING OF THE GRPE INFORMAL WORKING GROUP ON ELECTRIC VEHICLES AND THE ENVIRONMENT (EVE)

On invitation of the EVE leadership, the 21st informal working group meeting on Electric Vehicles and the Environment will take place in Geneva, Switzerland:

The objective of the 21st EVE IWG meeting will be to review the formal document outlining the new mandate approved at the 170th session of the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29).

The group will discuss next steps for the four work topics from the previous mandate, namely:

- Method of stating energy consumption (China)
- Battery performance and durability (Canada and USA)
- Determining power of EVs (Germany and Korea)
- Battery recyclability (Secretary)
