Background (1)

Due to some problems in 2016 it has not been possible to start the WLTP ISC Task Force.

The ISC TF has held its kick-off meeting on 16 March 2017 and has been chaired by the Commission.

In the meantime the Commission has started the preparation of the RDE 4th act, dealing with ISC and independent tests.

Also the WLTP Transposition Task Force, dealing with the adaptation of the GTR 15 into a UN Regulation, has started its work.

Background (2)

A CIRCABC folder dedicated to WLTP ISC has been set up and all the working documents are uploaded there.
The most relevant documents will be also delivered to the WLTP IWG and uploaded to the UNECE-GRPE WLTP IWG folder.

Kick-Off meeting (1)

- The Commission presented a proposal for the Mandate and ToR for the ISC TF that has been discussed and is now being revised.
- ACEA provided an overview of the current ISC procedure in EU.
- Korea gave a presentation on the Road Load verification programme, which is part of their ISC procedure.

Kick-Off meeting (2)

- The Commission presented the current status of the RDE 4th act concerning ISC and independent test provisions.
- Japan provided a summary of their main ideas about ISC.
- In the second part of the meeting the Commission showed the main lines of the CoP procedure.

What comes next

- A web-phone conference of the ISC TF is scheduled on 26 April 2017 (it might be postponed)
- Japan is discussing internally about whether/how/when introducing the ISC procedure in their vehicle emission legislation.
- The position/intention of the other parties of the WLTP is needed in order to agree on a harmonized procedure.

Concluding remarks

- The work of the ISC TF has started in March 2017.
- At the moment it does not seem possible to define a clear path for the ISC-CoP TF.
- The technical (and political) progress of the ISC-CoP depends on a series of factors:
 - Positions of the Parties regarding ISC-CoP
 - Development of the Transposition project
 - Progress of the EU RDE 4th act
- Probably a re-examination of the whole ISC-CoP project will be necessary before the end of 2017.
