In detail, the following topics were discussed:

- OICA 41: Additional T.P.s for “sundown of ECE-R10-04”
  - Ariel Lecca presents the proposal of changes to implement a kind of “indirect sundown”
  - Addition of §13.11. and rename old §13.11. as §13.12.  
India / Spain / Italy / France / Japan: agreement.
  - Addition of §13.13.  
India / Spain / Italy / France / Japan: agreement.
  - Addition of §13.14.  
India / Spain / Italy / France / Japan: agreement.
  - Addition of §13.15.  
India / Spain / Italy / France / Japan: agreement.  
Remark from Mr. Blanc that the narrow limits are probably changing in ECE-R10-05 suppl.2. Mr. Lecca replies that the limits in R10.03 are more stringent than the R10.05. Agreement.

Conclusion: OICA proposal on Transitional Provisions is adopted.

Question from Mr. Lecca if it could be possible to simplify the wording of the Transitional Provisions in the paragraphs 13.1. to 13.4. for 03 series and paragraphs 13.5. to 13.10. for 04 series?

→Spain / Japan / Italy: to keep as it is. India: no comment.

→France is in favour to delete the previous paragraphs for more clarification but there is no real concern in keeping them.

Conclusion: to keep the Transitional Provisions as it is.

- OICA 42
  - Disagreed by OICA; will be discussed for Version 6
- China 8 – To update the figures for motorcycles:
  - Figure 2b in Annex 4, Appendix 1: replacement by the correct figure.  
→Spain / Italy / India / France / Japan: agreement.
  - Figure 2 in Annex 6, Appendix 1: replacement by the correct figure.  
→Spain / Italy / India / France / Japan: agreement.

New comments by IMMA from June 19<sup>th</sup>

- IMMA 2 – new item **Section 7.1.4**, Artificial Networks and Appendix 8
  - DC-charging network with C2 1µF to be in line with CISPR12 (now on CDV level) but not yet with CISPR 25, which will be updated with this value. So the C2 value of 1 µF is intentional (see Excel sheet)
  - To be consistent, in the title of the figures “HV” will be deleted
- All other items could be supported by IMMA.

Scheduling: Until July 29<sup>th</sup> the official paper has officially to be submitted by the TF EMC to the GRE. A “clean” version have to be prepared by OICA (*Action Item 6-1, OICA*).

New information from CISPR/D/WG1 and 2: An optimization of AN descriptions were discussed. To have the R10-05 in line with the CISPR a new proposal about this topic will be discussed at OICA TF EMC at July17<sup>th</sup>. This proposal should be discussed also in the GRE TF EMC before end of July.

The Contracting Parties confirm the proposal.
