The Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations Office and other International Organisations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Secretary General – UN, Economic Commission for Europe, Inland Transport Committee and with reference to the Agreement concerning the establishing of global technical regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles, done at Geneva on 25 June 1998, has the honour to submit below the status report with respect to Global Technical Regulation No. 3 (GTR No. 3) on Motorcycle Brake Systems.

"India has taken following steps towards adoption of this GTR No. 3:

- Test facilities required for carrying out the test are under establishment.
- Indian national standard on motorcycle braking is under the final stage of revision with respect to the GTR requirements, for technical equivalence. This revised standard is expected to be released shortly. This revision has also considered the Amendment 1 to GTR No. 3. This revised standard will be subsequently notified for implementation."

"India will be reviewing the above plan periodically and would communicate to the Secretary General at appropriate time regarding the adoption of this GTR No. 3 on Motorcycle Brake Systems."
