“India has taken following steps towards adoption of this GTR No. 3:

- Test facilities required for carrying out the test are under establishment.
- Indian national standard on motorcycle braking is getting revised with respect to the GTR requirements, for technical equivalence. This also takes into consideration Amendment 1 to GTR No. 3.

“India will be reviewing the above plan periodically and would communicate to the Secretary General at appropriate time regarding the adoption of this GTR No. 3 on Motorcycle Brake Systems.”
