**ESTABLISHMENT OF AMENDMENT 1 TO
GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATION No. 2**

The Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, as Secretary of the Agreement, communicates the following:

On 14 November 2007, at its twenty-first session, the Executive Committee of the Agreement, in accordance with para. 7.2. of article 7 of Annex B to the Agreement, adopted by consensus vote (TRANS/WP.29/1064, para. 77) the following draft amendment:

Amendment 1 to global technical regulation No. 2 (Uniform provisions concerning the measurement procedure for two-wheeled motorcycles equipped with a positive or compression ignition engine with regard to the emissions of gaseous pollutants, CO₂ emissions and fuel consumption) (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2007/95).

The above amendment was established in the Global Registry as Amendment 1 to global technical regulation No. 2, entitled "MEASUREMENT PROCEDURE FOR TWO-WHEELED MOTORCYCLES EQUIPPED WITH A POSITIVE OR COMPRESSION IGNITION ENGINE WITH REGARD TO THE EMISSIONS OF GASEOUS POLLUTANTS, CO₂ EMISSIONS AND FUEL CONSUMPTION", under the symbol ECE/TRANS/180/Add.2/Amend.1.

The following document is, under the symbol ECE/TRANS/180/Add.2/Amend.1/Appendix 1, appended to the Amendment 1 to global technical regulation No. 2:

Proposal to amend a global technical regulation No. 2 (World-wide motorcycle emissions test cycle) (TRANS/WP.29/AC.3/19).
