## ESTABLISHMENT OF AMENDMENT 2 TO GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATION No. 4

The Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, as Secretary of the 1998 Agreement, communicates the following:

On 23 June 2010, at its twenty-ninth session, the Executive Committee of the Agreement established the following amendment in Global Registry, under the symbol ECE/TRANS/180/Add.4/Amend.2, by consensus vote (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/1085, para. 77) in accordance with paragraph 7.2. of Annex B to the Agreement:

Amendment 2 to global technical regulation No. 4 (Test procedure for compression-ignition (C.I.) engines and positive-ignition (P.I.) engines fuelled with natural gas (NG) or liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) with regard to the emission of pollutants) (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2010/48).
