"India has reviewed status of adoption of this GTR No. 4 on Test procedure for Compression Ignition (C.I.) Engines and Positive-Ignition (P.I.) Engines Fuelled with Natural Gas (NG) or Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) with regard to the Emission of Pollutants".

"The necessary test facilities and infrastructure needed is expected to be available in the country after the year 2015".

"India will be reviewing the above process periodically and would communicate to the Secretary-General at appropriate time regarding the status of implementation of this GTR".
