The Permanent Mission of Japan to the International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe and, with reference to Japan's submission of a status report on the regulations established under the AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHING OF GLOBAL TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES, concluded in Geneva on 25 June 1998, has the honor to submit the following report on the status of Global Technical Regulation (hereinafter referred to as the "UN GTR") No. 15 Amend. 6 and UN GTR No. 21 in Japan's domestic process in accordance with paragraph 7.4 of Article 7 of the abovementioned Agreement.

UN GTR No. 15 Amend. 6: Worldwide Harmonized Light Vehicle Test Procedures (WLTP)

UN GTR No. 21: Determination of Electrified Vehicle Power (DEVP)

The Government of Japan is considering whether UN GTR No. 15 Amend. 6 and UN GTR No. 21 can be incorporated into its national regulations through the revision of UN Regulation No. 154.

The Permanent Mission of Japan to the International Organizations in Geneva avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe the assurances of its highest consideration.
