


ACSF IWG 20th Meeting

Venue & Timings


▶ All meetings will take place at the Jury's Inn Hotel in Liverpool. The hotel is located next to the iconic Albert Docks.

Travel to the venue

- Delegates are advised to fly into Manchester Airport, which is under 2 hours from the venue.
- Trains run regularly from Manchester Airport to Liverpool Lime Street station. You can purchase Advance tickets <u>here</u>.
- The venue is located in front of the Wheel of Liverpool and is a 20-minute walk from Liverpool Lime Street station, as shown (<u>link</u>). You can also take a bus partway (<u>link</u>).
- Alternatively, there is a taxi rank in Liverpool Lime Street station. Uber also operate in the area.





Accommodation

- Delegates wishing to stay at the conference venue can do so at a reduced rate of £92 per person per night, which includes breakfast. To do so, please contact the venue directly (phone or e-mail) and quote the code 23707272. Note that the venue is only holding the rooms until 24th September 5th October; availability and price after that date are subject to change.

- Below are a number of alternative options, along with an estimate of the walking distance to the venue:
 - ▶ Ibis Liverpool Centre Albert Dock (~7 minutes)
 - ▶ Days Inn Liverpool (~11 minutes)
 - ▶ Hampton by Hilton Liverpool City Centre (~8 minutes)
 - ▶ Tune Hotel Liverpool (~14 minutes)
 - ▶ Hotel Indigo Liverpool (~18 minutes)



Things to do in Liverpool: Albert Dock and nearby



- Next to the venue and on the waterfront is Albert Dock (shown opposite), which offers a good variety of restaurants and cafes.
- The nearby Museum of Liverpool, Tate Liverpool, and the Merseyside Maritime Museum are all free to explore.
- Music fans can also explore The Beatles Story or take a trip on the Magical Mystery Tour bus.
- Slightly further North from Albert Dock, you can see the iconic Royal Liver Building, or check out the British Music Experience.



Things to do in Liverpool: Further afield

- More centrally located is the Cavern Club, famed for where the Beatles developed their sound.
- Football fanatics can also take a tour of Anfield stadium. A number of tour companies operate from just outside the Jury's Inn Hotel.
- The World Museum near Liverpool Lime Street station currently includes an exhibit on ancient Egypt.
- Next door to the World Museum is the Walker Art Gallery, which includes works by Rubens, Rembrandt, and Poussin.
