



# Swiss E-Mobility Roadmap 2022

A roadmap for e-mobility in Switzerland has been adopted on December 18 by Swiss Federal Councilor Mrs. Leuthard and over 50 private enterprises, industry associations and government agencies.

The aim of the roadmap is to achieve a 15% market share (today: 2.7%) for electric cars (meant as pure electric vehicles, plug-in and range extender vehicles) by 2022. In order to achieve this goal, participants of the roadmap have prepared measures which will be implemented starting 2019. The roadmap contains 65 measures in the clusters “market development”, “optimised charging infrastructure”, “incentives and framework conditions” and “federal measures”.

Direct subsidies for electric vehicles are not part of the roadmap. The role of the Swiss government is mainly to coordinate and enable initiatives by other players. Other examples of measures by federal government are the pre-financing of fast charging points at resting places along the motorways by the federal roads office or the collection and publication of Life-Cycle-Assessment (LCA) data on electric vehicles by the federal office for the environment.
