# Status Report from UNR WLTP Transposition Task Force



## Post-25th WLTP IWG Update

- 78<sup>th</sup> GRPE Geneva, January 2019
  - Agreement to delay UNR WLTP Working Document by one GRPE session submission to UNECE in October 2019 for 80<sup>th</sup> GRPE in January 2020
  - GRPE recognised the urgency for the task force to work on the definition of the most stringent, harmonized level (Level 2)
  - Japan and EC both agreed with the objective of harmonisation
  - OICA supported harmonisation, but stressed the need for the UNR to be technically and economically feasible
- February/March bilateral meetings between EC and MLIT
  - Updates made towards harmonisation of issues/topics where there are currently regional options – revised document prepared for discussion at Transposition Task Force and 26th WLTP IWG



## Post-25th WLTP IWG Update

- 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019 Transposition Task Force meeting, Tokyo
  - Further discussions on regional options to be continued at 26th WLTP
    IWG. Discussions on Durability test to be continued at 26th WLTP IWG

  - Further discussions on harmonisation, including Durability and COP
  - Review of draft regulatory texts
  - Discussions/agreement on specific technical elements, including amongst others:
    - Dual-axis dyno restraint and ALR test
    - Target speed correction
- Task Force meeting planned for 8<sup>th</sup> May 2019
  - Drafting of UNR WLTP text
- Informal documents to be submitted to 79th GRPE (May 2019)
  - UNR WLTP and UNR83 08 Series
    - With square brackets and holding comments as appropriate (e.g. for COP where it is unlikely that draft requirements will have been agreed by GRPE)
