FRAV-01 Consensus Outcomes

Scope

- 3+ wheeled vehicles
 - Excludes powered two wheelers (PTW)
 - Includes unconventional (e.g., "urban shuttle") and light 3-4-wheel (e.g., L4-7)
- FRAV Understanding: Combination of ToR elements necessitates highlevel definition of functionality (addressing the Framework Document safety elements noted in the ToR)

FRAV-VMAD Responsibilities


- FRAV and VMAD co-equal
- Collaboration and alignment essential
- Necessary for both groups to start from high level and work down towards necessary level of specificity
- FRAV defines "safe vehicle"
 - Descriptions of safety and performance requirements: "Expected Behavior"
 - "Pass/Fail" performance criteria
- VMAD defines how to assess vehicle is "safe"
 - Assessment that performance requirements satisfied
