Invitation to the 2nd Session of the GRVA Informal Working Group on Functional Requirements for Automated/Autonomous Vehicles (FRAV)

The second session of the FRAV informal group will take place during 14-15 January 2020 in Tokyo, Japan. The session will be hosted by the Japan Automobile Standards Internationalization Center (JASIC). Information on the meeting venue, hotel accommodations, and other logistical details can be found in the attachment to this invitation (FRAV-02-00/Att.1).

The first-day session (14 January) will be held in the 7th Floor Conference Room from 9:30 to 18:00. The second-day session (15 January) will be held in the 4th Floor Conference Room from 9:30 to 12:30. A joint session of FRAV and the Validation Methods for Automated Driving (VMAD) group will be held from 14:30 to 17:30. VMAD will meet after the FRAV session during 16-17 January.

Session Objectives

This session of FRAV will focus on the following items:

- Draft roadmap for meeting the FRAV objectives per the terms of reference (<u>GRVA-04-13</u>) and WP.29 AV Framework Document (<u>WP.29/2019/34/Rev.1</u> and <u>WP.29-179-25</u>)
- 2. Review of SR1 vehicle categories towards identifying possible automated vehicle configurations outside the scope of the current definitions (<u>Special Resolution No. 1 concerning the common definitions of vehicle categories</u>, masses and dimensions)
- 3. The revised list of candidate safety elements prepared by OICA (FRAV-01-13/Rev.1)
- 4. Common functional performance requirements for automated/autonomous vehicles

Towards this end, stakeholders have been requested to review the comparison of national/regional guidelines prepared by OICA (VMAD-01-04), the revised list of safety elements noted above, Table 1 of the AV Framework Document, and the "Framework for Automated Driving System Testable Cases and Scenarios" prepared by NHTSA (FRAV-01-14). Interested stakeholders are encouraged to submit draft descriptions for candidate functional performance requirements for automated/autonomous vehicles.

The main objective of this session is to reach consensus on a list of common functional performance requirements for delivery to GRVA at its February session.
