# Recent drafting sessions (teleconference)

- Five 2-hour drafting sessions held by teleconference since Geneva:
  - Wed 12 February
  - Mon 24 February
  - Thu 27 February
  - Thu 5 March
  - Tue 10 March
- We had hoped to discuss the GTR status at EVE face-to-face, March 23-24. However:
  - Strict GRPE 12-week deadline (for translation) is March 17
  - EVE face-to-face has been canceled (WebEx instead)

# Status of GTR document

- All known open issues have reached resolution within drafting group
  - See “DEVP GTR issue resolutions” spreadsheet
- A clean copy of the current draft GTR is on the EVE 34 website
  - For an outline of the most significant changes from ISO 20762, see Section E.1
  - Other changes may be seen in the spreadsheet
- The GTR is currently divided into two sections:
  - Section I is the technical rationale and justification (p. 2-31)
    - It is intended that this will serve as the “Technical Report”
    - Read this section for background on the development of the current procedure
    - Some late test results from Canada and JRC will be included when available
  - Section II is the draft procedure (p. 32-53)
  - Section III and IV are Annex 1 and 2 (p. 54-60)

# Next steps

- Today: provide informational overview and status of the GTR to EVE
- Tuesday, 17 March is the deadline for submission of a “near final” document 12 weeks prior to GRPE
- After this date, we are told that small revisions may be provided in redline markup for consideration at GRPE
- The drafting group will likely meet again soon to explore the need for such revisions prior to GRPE
- EVE is encouraged to provide any additional input during this period
