

document "OICA Low T Family concept comments 2020-01-28.pdf". H.M. indicated that the most critical point from their perspective is to reduce the number of added test vehicles under the Type 6 test. In the presentation it was suggested that it would be more suitable to use the power-to-cycle energy ratio instead of the currently proposed power-to-mass ratio. This would keep the same vehicles to be tested as in the Type 1 procedure.
