

Mr. Fredrik Zetterquist Managing Director, Swedesurvey

Swedesurvey is the state-owned overseas agency of Lantmäteriet, the Swedish national mapping, cadastral and land registration authority.

Since the beginning of the 1980s, Swedesurvey has exported the competencies and experience of Lantmäteriet throughout the world as part of the Swedish Government Policy for Global Development.

Mr. Zetterquist gained his MSc in Land Administration at The Royal Institute of Technology, Stockholm, in 1991. After his study he worked as a lecturer in cadastral surveying and mapping for four years and was then employed by Swedesurvey, responsible for establishment of a Land Management Department at the University of Novgorod, Russia. After his return to Sweden in 1996, and until 2008, he worked as adviser and project manager in numerous long-term land administration and capacity development projects throughout the world. Between 1996 and 1998, he did part-time PhD studies in 3D city modelling.

Mr. Zetterquist also founded a company to conduct due diligence for larger companies on landrelated matters. Between 2008 and 2011, as the Deputy Director he was instrumental in bringing up a large-scale farm enterprise in Russia, which was strictly compliant with global social, ethical, environmental and legal performance indicators. After one year of employment at Lantmäteriet's International Department, Mr. Zetterquist was appointed his current position as Managing Director at Swedesurvey in September 2012.
