After graduating in Law, Mrs. Tatjana Cenova Mitrevska employed in the private Law office working as a Junior Partner – Lawyer. After 5 and a half years working in private law office, Mrs. Tatjana Cenova Mitrevska become civil servant in the Agency for real estate cadastre in 1992. Following 10 years working on different positions related to establishment and maintenance of real estate cadastre, internal control and second degree commission for decision-making on appeal's of the citizens on registration processes, she got a managerial level. From 2004 till end of 2015 she was also a Project Director/Manager of the:

- The World Bank funded Real estate cadastre and registration project – RECRP - first phase and additional financing (which was implemented in AREC from 2005-2015) and
- Two sub project that were implemented under main RECR Project (PHRD project for preparation of RECRProject funded by the Kingdom of Japan and Pilot project Kumanovo funded by the grant of Kingdom of Holland).

As a project manager her main task is to supervise project implementation by the sector, division and field office teams, and day-to-day project management unit (PMU) operation; to review progress on project implementation; to manage the development of the annual work plans and coordinate the budget planning and approval process; oversee the activities, monitoring and evaluation, finance disbursement and procurement; take actions to expedite project activities.

At the present she holds the position of state advisor to the Director of the Agency for Real Estate Cadastre (AREC) for coordination of international and national activities and strategic planning.

Her main task is to advise the Director on the resolution of the most complex issues and on the implementation of the work program of the Agency concerning the strategic planning, euro-integrations, marketing and training, to coordinate the activities of the Agency under international projects in the field of geodesy, law, real estate cadastre and IT and activities in reference to the development of policies related to access to donor funds, European funds and international institutions as well as activities in performing consultant services and training in the country and abroad, including logistical activities, to perform the most complex tasks in reference to issues related to establishment, maintenance, development and advancement of international cooperation with the

competent authorities or institutions from other countries in the field of geodesy, law, real estate cadastre and IT for the benefit of the management as well as the advancement and technical development of the Geodetic Cadastre Information System, to draft opinions on issues in this area that require highest level management decisions and to provide recommendations in reference strategic planning within AREC.
