*Additional to presentation:*

*If someone would find more digitalisation related topics in WP11 reports is invited to share it with us next sessions.*

*Business wallet is being prepared as well, so we would need to look at the proposal what is the principle to integrate documents.*

*Legal basis to include ATP certificate in any form of wallet needs to be prepared in ATP legislation. Trusted list of who will be allowed to issue can relate to competent authorities list. This needs to be addressed in legal framework establishment.*

*Process of 'flow of information to share' should be addressed in next sessions.*

*Two main process flows are recognised in ATP:*

- *Flow of Verification of ATP certificate and*
- *flow of issuing of ATP Certificate.*

*During presentation most of focus was on first one, since second one is quite complex certification process. System similar to EU COVID Certificate / WHO Global Digital Health Certification Network seems quite appropriate.*

*It was confirmed by Portugal representative, that there is a big will to find some good solution for digitalisation of ATP Certificate, and expressed that today there is indirect verification method with official certificate database connected to printout documents with QR code link to this database, but no measures are taken on protection from false web link to fake certificates and fake database of certificates could appear.*

*Question about using digital database to issue ATP certificates raised, it was confirmed that on our previous session we already discussed what the practices of issuing certificates in form of pdf QES are signed documents and options to digitally check them with web link based QR codes.*

*Important question we need to research more is safety of digital data transfer and what is fraud risk in using some of technology.*

#### **4 Available regulations and standards for the safe checks on the issuance of digital certificates**

- **eFTI Regulation** — mr. Mario Rodríguez González made presentation, PPT is in wikispace.

*It was recommended to ask European commission specialised committee for digitalisation on eFTI how ATP certificate could be integrated in eFTI environment, since eFTI is developed for transportation data, ATP Certificate is related to equipment data, but ATP relates to equipment and transport, so we should make more clarification to support our question.*

#### **5 Options for the use of a digital ATP certificate of compliance in the light of paperless transport such as eCMR**

- **e-CMR – Slovenia** – mr. Matjaž Auflič made presentation, PPT is in wikispace.

*It was recommended that good definition of paper based-physical document process flow should be base for digitalisation flow, which is hardly recommended to be integrated in legal framework of ATP*

*agreement. When ready Pilot projects are the one which confirm suitability of defined solution, so it is recommended to think of it to start as soon as possible.*

*It was cleared the according to article 6 of e-CMR – ATP certificate can be added in e-CMR as ‘external approved document’.*
