Guinea specified that passengers are not subject to a COVID-19 PCR test upon arrival, and which documents are required to enter.

Current regulations

Passengers must have:

- a negative COVID-19 PCR test result taken at most 72 hours before departure from the first embarkation point; or
- a COVID-19 vaccination certificate showing that they were fully vaccinated with:
 - Janssen at least 28 days before arrival; or
 - AstraZeneca (SK Bioscience), AstraZeneca (Vacczenta), Covishield, Moderna (Spikivax), Pfizer-BioNTech (Cominabty), Sinopharm (BBP), Sinovac or Sputnik V at least 14 days before arrival; or
 - a COVID-19 recovery certificate issued at most 6 months before arrival.

This does not apply to passengers younger than 5 years.
